

Easy Jewelry for your doll

Supplies Needed:

Sulky Metallic thread for chain-gold
No-hole beads-gold or rose
Focal bead-flat back pearl or 5ss gem stone

Making the Focal bead

Punch a circle out of thin card using a 1/8" paper punch.
Lightly glue this circle onto a piece of foil to hold it steady.
Glue a flat-back pearl or 5ss gem stone in the center of your circle.
Add glue around edge and place no-hole beads around pearl/gem.
Add a coat of gloss Mod Podge to seal.
When dry, peel carefully from foil to use on necklace.

The Sulky Metallic thread is wrapped around the neck or display board with the ends going under the focal bead so as to have a neat back of necklace. Glue focal bead over glued down ends. Dabs of glue and no-hole beads are added along the necklace for interest. Let dry. Seal with gloss Mod Podge.

Earrings: Dip the ends of Sulky Metallic thread in glue and then no-hole beads making a cluster. Let dry. Seal with gloss Mod Podge.
